## CRITICS PICK: NEW YORK TIMES and LOS ANGELES TIMES

Nominated for 5 Israeli Academy Awards, and the hit of the Chicago Jewish Film Festival 2017.

An accident during a bar mitzvah celebration leads to a gender rift in a devout Orthodox community in Jerusalem, in this rousing, good-hearted tale about women speaking truth to patriarchal power.

When the women's balcony in an Orthodox synagogue collapses, leaving the rabbi in shock and his wife in a coma, the congregation falls into crisis. Charismatic young Rabbi David appears to be a savior after the accident, but slowly starts pushing his fundamentalist ways and tries to take control, testing the women's friendships and creating a between the community's women and men.
