We are excited to report that on July 2, 2021, the CCAR Office of Rabbinic Career Services officially posted Congregation BJBE's Senior Rabbinic application. In crafting the application, we drew from many sources and many different voices. Most importantly, we relied heavily upon the findings in the Gesher L'Atid Visioning Report. This was especially true when determining the qualities and priorities that our congregation seeks from our new Senior Rabbi. As a reminder, all of the Visioning Report's findings came directly from the 18 tent talks that took place this Spring as well as the congregational survey. Therefore, this application truly reflects the values of our BJBE community. Included below are links to the Visioning Report as well as our Rabbinic application.

It is our understanding that we will receive our initial group of resumes sometime after July 12. After that, we will receive the resumes on a rolling basis. While we do not have a specific timeline, we anticipate that the first round of Zoom interviews will begin in August. The Gesher L'Atid Search Committee is now beginning to prepare for the interview process. There will be two rounds of Zoom interviews and the final candidates will come to BJBE for in-person interviews. As always, we appreciate your support and will continue to keep you apprised of all that is taking place.
