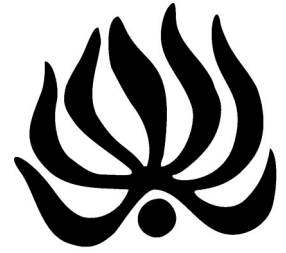




High Holy Days Food Drive
