Genetic counselors from the Ann & Robert H. Lurie Children's Hospital of Chicago will be available to address both general and personal questions. Hospital staff will take samples for screening. (Results are confidential.)

Program fee: \$180 per person. **These tests usually cost more than \$4,000!** For alternative payment options, please contact the Center.
